Health Emergency Management British Columbia (HEMBC) provides emergency management leadership and support to British Columbia's health system. HEMBC staff work to ensure that BC can effectively plan for, respond to, and recover from extreme events impacting the health system. This work includes the development and implementation of strategic and operational emergency management plans and programs, from health care facilities to the Ministry of Health.

The Emergency Management Unit (EMU) is an integral component of HEMBC with responsibility for ensuring that the Ministry of Health (MoH) is prepared to respond to emergency events that impact MoH operations and/or that impact the health system. This includes providing leadership to the MoH's emergency management program and ensuring that MoH staff are prepared to play leadership roles in managing an emergency that impacts the MoH and/or the health system.

To mitigate the impacts of any provincial health emergency, the Emergency Manager takes a leadership role in the development, maintenance, monitoring, and improvement of Ministry emergency response and business continuity plans; the development and integration of emergency response exercises and training; and, supporting emergency response operations and operational readiness. This position also involves regular assumption of the role of Provincial Health Duty Officer, which serves as a 24/7 emergency contact point for health partners, requiring judgement and tact while managing time-sensitive issues.

The work environment requires the position to be mobile and travel is occasionally required within British Columbia and throughout Canada and the US as required. Due to the nature of the work, this position is required to be available 24/7 to lead and assist in all forms of emergency response management. If you thrive in an environment dedicated to cooperation and teamwork, and enjoy working towards group and organizational goals in support of a resilient health system, we look forward to your application.

Qualifications for this role include:

- University degree in education, emergency management, health, business or public administration or other related field and two (2) years related experience in emergency and business continuity management, policy and program development. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Prefer postgraduate degree.
- Experience reviewing and analyzing complex multi-faceted issues related to health planning and health emergency planning.
- Demonstrated project management experience.
- Experience working effectively with internal and external stakeholders in the health care and/or non-health care fields.
