Emergency Management British Columbia (EMBC) is the lead coordinating agency in the provincial government for all emergency management activities. As such, EMBC's mission is to be responsible to British Columbians for leading the management of provincial level emergencies and disasters and supporting other authorities within their areas of jurisdiction. EMBC works directly with local governments, First Nations, provincial ministries and agencies, federal departments, other jurisdictions, industry and volunteers in hazard mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery.

EMBC is developing a province-wide Recovery Framework which will include the development of strategies, including: regulations, policies, programs, standards and plans, to achieve emergency recovery outcomes consistent with government and EMBC priorities. The Framework will include multiple components to address the complexities of various emergency types; potential impacts; regions of the province; and other complexities. Development of the Framework will involve forming vital partnerships and negotiating agreements with key leaders of private sector agencies, all levels of government, First Nations and other stakeholders. It will also incorporate best practices from other jurisdictions, including those who have experienced disasters that involved significant damage or loss of life.

The Recovery Planning Manager operates at a strategic level and is relied upon to lead the development and implementation of the province-wide recovery framework. The Manager provides advice and recommendations to executives regarding all aspects of the recovery framework and strives to ensure outcomes are consistent with EMBC priorities. The Manager works in close collaboration with senior representatives of EMBC, all levels of government, First Nations, and the private and non-profit sectors. In provincial emergencies, the Manager contributes to the establishment of provincial emergency coordination and/or response centres; and fulfills a key role in the leadership and oversight of recovery operations. The Manager also contributes to the advancement of inter-jurisdictional and nation-wide recovery agreements, standards, policies, programs and best practices, including reciprocal resource sharing initiatives to facilitate recovery from significant events.

Qualifications for this role include:

- University Degree in emergency management; OR
- University Degree in another discipline with education and/or training in emergency management; OR
- An equivalent combination of emergency management-related education and/or training.
- A minimum of 1 years' recent, related experience:
- Leading and managing the development and implementation of regulations, policies, programs and/or plans in a large organization; AND
- Developing partnerships and collaborating with leaders of public, private and/or non-profit organizations.
